The institution is registered with Society as an autonomous institution on the lines of SGPGI and affiliated with prestigious Kings' Georges Medical University Lucknow

GIMS was established with an aim to improve the status of health of the rural and urban population of western Uttar Pradesh, by providing a state-of-the-art health facility as well as facilitating equitable access to quality health care through a revamped health care system, targeted outreach services as well as involvement of community and local bodies. GIMS is located in Greater Noida, near Kasna in Gautam Buddha Nagar and caters to the districts of western Uttar Pradesh, Haryana, Uttarakhand and Rajasthan.

The institute has state of the art infrastructure, modular operation theaters, well equipped high-end equipment and NABL accredited laboratories, and highly advanced Skill lab. The hospital is 500 bedded, fully functional providing comprehensive care in all the broad specialties. The patient load in the OPD as well as inpatients is increasing day by day. There are approximately 1500-2000 patients are visiting every day and more than 250 patients are admitted in the hospital. The hospital is planning to establish multi-disciplinary Research unit (MRU), Viral Research development laboratory, Paramedical training institute, skill development center and Medical Incubation center.








In-patients data: 2018 &2019


