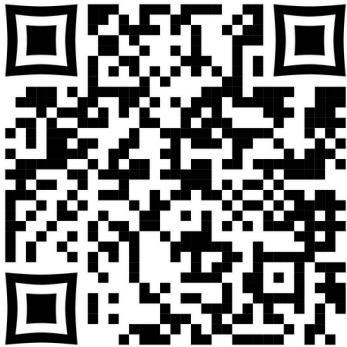
DESCRIPTION OF THE MODULE
