3. EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN (EMT)

Brief Job Description

Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) in the Healthcare Industry is also known as a lifesaver or paramedic. Individuals at this job need to provide emergency medical support and care to individuals who are critically ill or injured and transport them to a medical facility within stipulated time limits

Training Outcomes

At the end of the program, the learner should have acquired the listed knowledge and skills.

- Demonstrate knowledge about the healthcare sector and emergency medical care services
- Demonstrate the ability to perform clinical skills essential in providing basic emergency medical care services such as urgent need to respond the emergency calls, assurance of scene safety, precision to call other emergency people, handling different emergency scenarios from clinical emergency to trauma emergency to mass casualty to disaster management, etc.
- Demonstrate setting of an ambulance for dealing with emergency situations
- Practice infection control measures
- Demonstrate safe and efficient transferring and ambulation techniques

4. GERIATRIC CARE ASSISTANT

Brief Job Description

Provides routine individualized care to geriatrics at hospitals/ home set up/old age homes/community centers etc. They assist in maintaining activities of daily living for geriatrics & work in collaboration with healthcare team, individuals and care takers to deliver the prescribed healthcare services.

Training Outcomes

At the end of the program, the learner should have acquired the listed knowledge and skills.

- Discuss & verbalize the role of a Geriatric Care Assistant.
- List the basic healthcare needs of ambulatory conscious elderly people, non-ambulatory / bed-ridden frail elderly people etc.

- Enhance their skill and capacities in counsel and manage older persons who are at home, admitted in healthcare institutions
- Enhance their knowledge in resource management, advocacy and related to care of older persons
- Demonstrate techniques to maintain the personal hygiene needs of an elderly patient
- Practice infection control measures

5. PHLEBOTOMIST

Brief Job Description

A Phlebotomist draws blood samples from patients for laboratory testing and analysis and also guides patients in collection of other type of samples like urine, stool, sputum, etc. This may be done at the laboratory, collection centre, or at the client site. The incumbent also ensures availability and suitability of supplies to be used in the process. The person is also responsible for other activities such as labelling, record keeping and other related documentation

Training Outcomes

At the end of the program, the learner should have acquired the listed knowledge and skills.

- Organize pre-procedural requirements of sample collection such as necessary equipment and supplies etc
- Perform sample collection following best practices
- Prepare the patient for special procedures.
- Instruct the patients in collection of other types of samples such as urine, stool, sputum, etc.
- Carry out transfer and storage of samples.
- Prepare for site visits while following visit etiquettes.
- Maintain professional behavior with co-workers, patients and their families.
- Co-ordinate with colleagues and other people to complete work
- Apply the health, safety and security protocols at the workplace such as effective infection control protocols to ensure the safety of self, patient and colleagues
- Follow infection control, sanitization, disinfection and bio medical waste protocols.

6. DIABETES ASSISTANT

Brief Job Description

A Diabetes Assistant works in direct coordination with Diabetes Educator in developing a comprehensive, cost effective and Diabetes Self-Management Education (DSME) plan for individuals suffering from prediabetic and diabetic symptoms. The candidate is involved in imparting the understanding of the effects of healthy behavior and lifestyle on acute and chronic problems related to diabetes

Training Outcomes

At the end of the program, the learner should have acquired the listed knowledge and skills.

- Perform the clinical as well as administrative role and responsibilities of a diabetes assistant.
- Identify risk factors of diabetes and increase awareness for its prevention.
